Install and share are 2 different things.

You mentioned that you had an error but you didn't give it.

If you don't have the "share" option available then you have to check if you are using MySQL 5.x or still using MySQL 4.x.

I don't see any changed in the RSEvents and its definition is exactly the same. So perhaps you have another RSEvents version that has another definition that is not defined for the JMS Tools and template.

The latest RSEvents version that we reviewed is the 1.0.0. Rev 19.

So provided detailed description and error messages that allow identifying what is different in your current project.
