I am trying to use the Ninja RSS Syndicator which seems to work fine, other than that the feeds appear to overwrite each other.

For instance:

http://www.workingforwiltshire.com/index.php?option=com ninjarsssyndicator&feed id=2&format=raw

produces the same feed as

http://www.chippenhamlibdems.org.uk/index.php?option=com ninjarsssyndicator&feed id=2&format=ra w

even though they are produced by two different slave sites.

I recognise that this is probably due to the plug-in not being compatible with Multi-Sites so my question is:

i) can it be made to work; or ii) is there a RSS syndicator that is compatible?

Generally, RSS feeds call the website using the port written in the URL. Perhaps you have to add a synonym in the slave site that correspond to workingforwiltshire.com:80 and chippenhamlibdems.org.uk:80

to avoid reading the "default" website (the master website).
