The alias link must be a directory and this is normal that you don't have such directory on your disk. Probably you want to write {root}/{site\_alias} {root} correspond to the full path corresponding to the domain.

In your description, it seems that you want twice deploy the slave site in the same directory than the alias. Deploy folder and alias link are used when you want 2 directories linked together.

For example deploy the slave site into {site\_dir} and create a link to this directory from {root}/{site\_id}
