It is NOT written "slave id" that was my interpretation of (slave)record 1 field "id" the error is located in the id field.

Yes I created a fresh slave site. I used an existing DB PHP 5 when installed it and removed all old records. My deploy directory is root_dir/slave. My master dir is root_dir/master. The master is also a fresh install.

Do you think that I will be able to reproduce it.

You should be able to reproduce the error... the only difference: I use 1 and 1 shared hosting using php.ini in each deployed dir.

I just created another slave but this time I installed it in root_dir/master/slave2

It is also showing the same error in the Master (dotcom) .

The error

Mean that Joomla 1.6.0 is not able to connect on the DB.
This is like the user and password that you provide to connection on the DB Server is not able to select the DB name you specified.

Your video does not show my multisite configuration so I do not see why this tutorial will pertain to me.

In the video you are creating a (subdomain as the master) and a jms2win.com/master/slave as the slave.

In the video you never show multiple domains, you are using the same domain (jms2win.com) each time to create subdomains with the same database.

- jms2win.com/
- jms2win.com/master/
- jms2win.com/master/slave1/
- jms2win.com/master/slave1/slave2/

My multisite configuration is:

- masterdomain.com
- slavedomain1.com
- slavedomain2.com
- slavedomain3.com

And I am using separate databases not the same database, there is a huge difference compared to what you demonstrate.

This is exactly the same in the video.
What ever the domain or subdomain or subdirectories, you written that you create a fresh slave site with a new Joomla installation using MySQLi.
This is what you can see in the video.
Change the domain name value does not change the creation of the slave site and the deploy directory does not change also the configuration.

This just demonstrate the the MySQLi ping function and the other "select" error that you report with the Joomla 1.6 library does not appear with our hosting company using cPanel.

Create and addOn Domain or a subdomain in cPanel with a "document root" give exactly the same result.

The database connection parameter is the one that you provide in Joomla Installer and not in JMS Multisites.

This is what is demonstrated with the Video and that the DB connection is correctly save and used by the slave.

Six months ago I tried to make your component work but GAVE UP. I felt my investment was wasted. I never followed up because I wanted to give some time for Joomla to stabilize since 1.6 was RC. After six months I still continue to receive the same type errors w/ Multi sites. Everything installs correctly and works up until I add another site. I am on a shared package 1and1 hosting. But I still continue to get errors with your Component, nothing else causes errors like this and I run several Joomla configurations since 2005.

After adding a slave site it installs correctly but when I try to Manage Site I get the following:
500 - An error has occurred.

joomla.library:3 - Could not connect to database
