I don't see the relationship between this thread title and the description that you give.

Sharing menu is not directly possible.

We propose a "Multisites Menu Item" extension that allows you creating a kind of sharing between the item of a menu. Not the menu itself.

Concerning the other question concerning the possibility to see all the VirtueMart products in the master, this is only possible when you share the VirtueMart extension between a master and the slaves but in this case, all the slave will also have all the products information.

So you can share the whole content of an extension or nothing but not partially.

The concept of the sharing is to share the MySQL tables used by the extension.

Sharing the table means that you share all the records. In other words, you share all the products, categories, ... (everything) and not only few records.

What you request is the "Multisites VirtueMart" that would be able, like our "Article Sharing for JMS" to read specific records of VirtueMart.

This extension does not exist.

The only thing that you could do is to share the whole VirtueMart and modify the VirtueMart PHP code to just display few categories depending on the websites.

This will require to modify VirtueMart itself and is not necessarily easy to develop.

Another solution would be to keep the virtuemart independent and develop a module or a component that would be able to display the list of products that exist in the other websites.

If you want that we develop such kind of extension or modifying the virtuemart to filter things, this kind can be analyzed and developed with our billable support that you can order at

    // This is the master  
    $site_id = ':master_db:';  
}
```

You don't need to include any files to have the MULTISITES_ID defined present. This defined is declared by JMS Multisites when this is a slave site. As this is a "define", you don't need to declare anything to have the define present. It is always present like a global parameter.

This is a plugin that is a kind of bridge or gateway between Jms Multi Sites and VirtueMart when you want to propose a service to sell the website creation from the front-end.

In this case, in addition to create a website, you need to have a system where to place an order and proceed to its payment. In our case, we propose a bridge with VirtueMart to process the website creation ordering until its payment.

The bridge communicate with Jms Multi Sites to build the VM shopping cart and also process all the VM order status modification in aim to update the slave site status.

It seems that you have defined a Site ID rule that use the {site_prefix} and the DB prefix that is u{user_id}{site_prefix}.

If your site ID correspond to the site prefix, you can rebuild the rule to get the DB prefix.

The relationship is the one that you have defined in your JMS Template rule and my analysis is correct correspond to the value that you have setup in your rule.

You don't find any table for the Jms Multi Sites extension as we don't save anything in the DB as we need to get the information before that joomla start and before any DB connection.

If you want to automatically redirect a user to a specific website, you have to imagine a rule somewhere that create the relationship between the user login and the slave site.

If you use the "owner" field that is associated to a slave site, you could perhaps retrieve the list of slave site that is owned by a particular user.

The problem is what you are doing when you have several websites assigned to a given user?

So if you propose a service to create websites from the front-end, you can limit the number of website to 1 in the JMS Template rule (Maximum Website per user).

If you want to create a plugin and have access to some website information, see the chapter 4 of the user manual that describes some API to get info from a specific website.
