Jms Multi Sites is an extension of more than 2MB and that may time a lot of time to execute. Once it is loaded, we try to increase the execution time but some environment may reject it.

An alternate solution is to install Jms Multi Sites from a directory like explained in the tutorial video 3. http://tutorial.jms2win.com/joomla/multisite-12x/cpanel/install-from-directory

This will reduce the time as the file will already be loaded and that should probably solve your problem. Otherwise, you have to try increasing your PHP max\_execution\_time parameter
