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The column that are displayed there (DB server, DB, prefix, user ) contain the value present in the configuration.php file that is located in the "deployed directory" of the slave site.

So if you slave site make reference to a deployed directory that does not exists, this mean that the "configuration.php" is not present and the DB connection can not be retrieved.

So check that you have the correct "deployed folder" value for each website and that it effectivelly correspond to the location where the slave site is present.
