Concerning JomSocial, it is effectively possible to share the users between the websites. In this case, this will share all the JomSocial content except the configuration.

So in terms of JomSocial group they will be shared. So the group in Site 1 will also the group in Site 2

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You can have separated DB for the websites but in this case you not not share the JomSocial user. All you could do is share the Joomla user but not the JomSocial info.

So you could only share the joomla username and password.
