If you decide to share the images directory then yes every slave can see this shared directory.

If you want to have a specific "images" directory for the slave site, this is possible. See the tutorial video that show how to have a specific images and templates directory. https://www.jms2win.com/en/tutorial#jms12x-CP-05

So share or have a specific images directory is a decision that you take when you create the slave site. In very short, to make a specific images directory, you have to create a JMS Template rule where you setup the "folder and file" with the action = "copy" for the "images" directory.
