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Hi

Here is my scenario - I have some posts but I want to be clear

I sell a website service for landlords and agent client to manage their maintenance requests and at the moment I am using Akeeba backup to setup the sites manually. For example, I have the site called [www.mypropertywebsite.co.uk](http://www.mypropertywebsite.co.uk). I then manually create the sub domain and upload the akeeba backup to the sub domain and install it. example [client1.mypropertywebsite.co.uk](http://client1.mypropertywebsite.co.uk)

So my question is this. Can I allow my new users to setup their account automatically with your extension? So they simply click a link and all the files are created on a sub domain with a new database so it is entirely independent from each other?

[>>> Client 1](http://client1.mypropertywebsite.co.uk) Own website and database - No access to other accounts

[>>> Client 2](http://client2.mypropertywebsite.co.uk) Own website and database - No access to other accounts

[>>> Client 3](http://client3.mypropertywebsite.co.uk) Own website and database - No access to other accounts

Etc etc

I use Siteground as a hosting provider

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I would say NO.

If you want to perform the backup of all the websites and have the symbolic links correctly saved, we have created a "Weekly backup shell script" that you can download at

Personnaly, we never been able to configure Akeeba backup to do a correct backup when restored but we have some customers that succeeded to do it.

So we will not be able to advise you how to setup akeeba backup to perform a correct backup of all your websites.

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
