I recently updated to ver 1.1.19 and while I was at it I figured I should update eXtplorer. I guess I did it in the wrong order...I uninstalled and reinstalled it on the master, then went to do the same on the slaves. But when I try to install on slave I get this:

This is probably an error in this extension itself.

I suppose that the "uninstall" file is not correctly placed in the component you have to installed.

Try to unzip this extension into a temporary directory and install it from this directory.

I suspect that you will have another error message more explicit that will tell you that an "uninstall" file is missing or not found.

In general, you have to copy the missing file into the root directory and that solve the problem.

If this is confirm, you could report this bug to the author of the extension.

This problem arise also when installing the master website from a directory instead of the package.
