We review some of our websites and find that some slave sites had the tag "Powered by jms2win" on the template. Some of the new websites didn't have this tag. I think that we install the extension and create some websites without register the extension until we get "Oh my god is unregistered and make the register" so some slave websites get the message on the template but the new ones doesn't. COuld this be correct? We can fix this on a batch process for the old websites? We need check something for doing that?

First the "powerby" is not displayed to the users.

It is present in the page for the SEO when you are setting up a slave site with specific default menu or speciifc default language or specific default template.

Otherwise, you should not have it.

So if you decided to replace the "default" joomla settings by the JMS one, check it that was really required.

For people who would have "powered by" or similar content from any extensions that they want to make disappear, an easy tips consists in writing a special "Search/Replace" rule to discard such pattern in a page.

Remark: Some extensions are using random text in the powered by to avoid that it is removed.
