I have a fresh Joomla 2.5.14 installation with JMS 1.3.18. Patches are installed.

I have a YooTheme and Widgetkit installed and on the slave-site they produce absolute paths for Javascript-Files.

I had to add the following to warp/src/Warp/Helper/PathHelper.php in the Theme, to remove the **Document Root:**

\$url = str_replace(\$_SERVER, ", \$url);

It seems to work now but it's not ideal for updates and so I would like a longterm solution.

Is this a bug in the theme or an issue with Multisites?
