You mentioned frm the "Maintenance" menu. This is not clear. Which maintenance menu. Do you mean the Joomla Extension Manager / install ? or something else.

The error let suppose that you are not runing on J3.2.1 but that would have a old Joomla 2.5 that does not have this function.

Does your Joomla 3.2.1 is a fresh installation or the upgrade form an older version of joomla ?

Can you describe the steps that you did to help us reproducing it.

Based on what we have understood:

- Installed JMS 1.3.7 in Joomla 3.2.1

- You have slave sites defined
- You go in JMS / Maintenance menu
- You selected the combo-box with "available for download".

There you selected again the "Joomla 3.2.1" packages.

- You clicked on the "Download Package" button to received the Joomla 3.2.1 as downloaded packages.

- You selected the Joomla 3.2.1 stable version AND you selected an existing slave site on which you want to upgrade on a new version.

> Can you describe the slave site on which you want to install J3.2.1

Is this a J2.5 website ?

As you described that you have installed JMS on J3.2.1 then I suppose that all the slave sites are already runing under J3.2.1

OR did you modified the JMS / Settings to provide a "Multisites Path" that is connected on another JMS with another Joomla version ?

Do you mean that once the clicked the "Install Package" tool bar button that you have the master website that crash ?

I read some day ago, and restore situation when i get website that crash. It's new domain, and first installation joomla 3.2.1, and then i firstly install JMS last vertion(full). Thinking what i need install packag in all part of menu JMS - i do it and get error in 'packag from JMS Maintenance'...Now i understand what JMS Maintenance part - it is for upgrade master and slave Joomla, and don't need do in first installation. May be that was reason error!!!

But!, i think problem yet all have.

When install new extentions (in master site from Joomla installation) i get error access to DB (master), for example installation K2:" 1146 Table '...master_k2_categories' doesn't exist SQL=SHOW FULL COLUMNS FROM `master_k2_categories`" I look in DB and don't find tables . I successfully install 3 fresh slave site where i specify admin DB (master) login and password. Then i see slave bases, but not other tables of new extentions (i check several) who need tables in DB.

If I understand correctly, what you did is:

- Install Joomla 3.2.1

- Install JMS Full edition

- Did you installed the JMS patches or not ?

- Do you go in the JMS "maintenance" menu ?

- If yes, after that, what are you doing ?

- Do you click on the download package (I suspect yes)

- After that I suppose that you tried to perform the "install of the package" but did you selected a website or not.

If you want to create a video rather than screenshot this is also possible.
