You have different method that can be used to perform the installation of an extension into the slave site.

- 1) Use the JMS Tool to perfom the install of an extension into a slave site.
- 2) Login in the back-end of the slave site and perform the re-install of the extension. Some extension use a special install procedure to install temporaly an extension that is used to finally install their own stuff. When they finish to install their own stuff, they uninstall. This may explain they are no more found in the master (or they have another name)

If you have a message like the extension does not exists in the master or with an incorrect version number, it is possible to disable this check performed by JMS when you go in the Settings menu. Change the "Ignore extension version" to YES.

Don't forget to restore to NO when you have finished the install in the slave sites.

3) Use the Joomla "extension manager" / discover => Install When you have the error message that an manifest of a version is incorrect (case 2), it is also highly probable that this procedure also fails.

If you don't have the menu "zoo" that is present in the slave site, try uninstalling it and re-installing it. Sometimes, when you had a problem during a previous installation, Joomla does not create the menu information and when you retry to re-install it, it considers this is an update without refreshing the menu. When you uninstall, the extension may sometimes cleanup the information and that solve the problem. Otherwise, try using the latest JMS 1.3.29 and the JMS tools menu that may help you installing an extension into a slave site. Becarefull that Zoo is a Yoothemes extension that requires additional patches to fix bugs in the WARP framework that is copied in each extensions.
