The pdf icon functions fine when the SH404 is OFF.
Better stick with Joomla Built-in SEF for time being.
In addition, I also found out the current version of SEH404 SEF (1.0.16_Beta - build_222 - Joomla 1.5.x) & Joom!fish V2.0.1 not really compatible. Still have some problems
