Then when I go to the ACP or Site - it prompts me to install again vicious cycle.

It loops because the "configuration.php" is probably not written by the Joomla Installation.  A potential reason is a permission problem.
You also have to check if at the end of the installation, Jommla does not prompt you that it has a problem to save the configuration.  Sometimes, Joomla prompt the configuration data into a text area that must be written manually into the "configuration.php" files that is located into the /multisites/xxxx where xxxx is the site ID.
Perhaps you will have to use the FTP Configuration parameter to grant Joomla with more permissions.  See tutorial step 15 that show how to setup the FTP Layer.

You have to re-install the extension with exactly the same version than the one previously installed on the

master website.

To avoid re-installation of the extension, JMS provide the possibilty to replicate a website.

You can define the website replication rules in the "Website template".

Once you have defined the rules, you can later use this "Website template" to create new website and this will also replicate all the content of the website given in template.

Therefore all the pre-installed extension will also be replicated.
